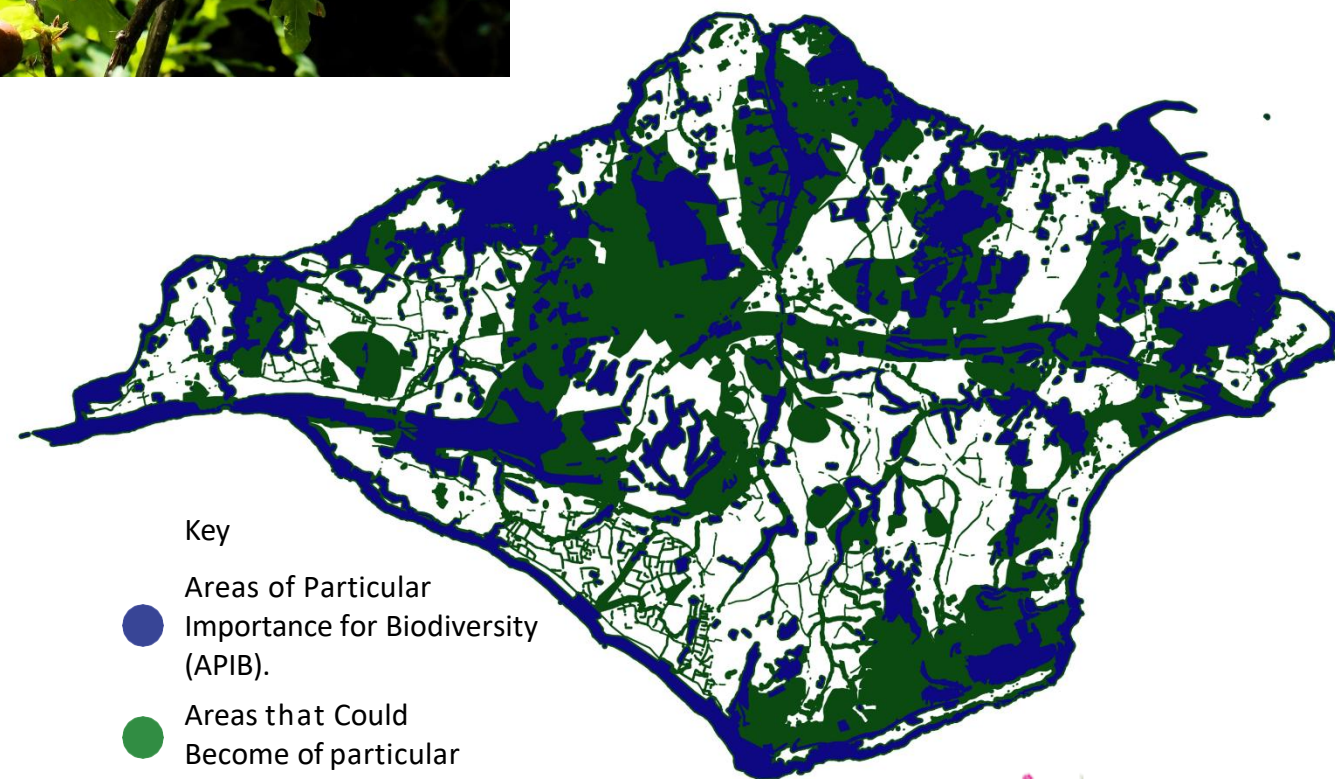

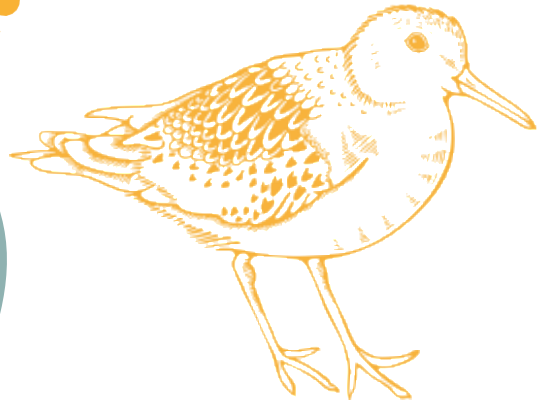

Padina pavonica Surveys: South Island Coast

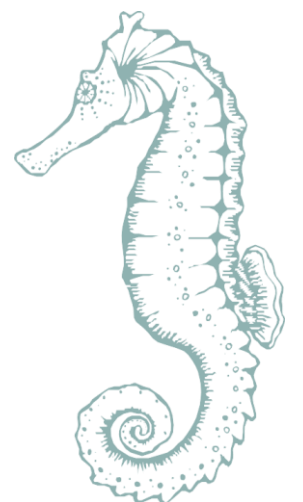
Surveys to understand the distribution of Padina. P across the Isle of Wight coastline – potential to support populations with eco-engineered interventions
